6	findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally walves all
7	such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts, Order of
8	Suspension and Probation (Stipulation and Final Order); (II) this Stipulation and Final Order is a
9	public document and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this
0.	Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the
1	Commission. If the Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order,
2	then neither Mr. Porath nor the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully
