6	On May 7, 2007, the Teache	r Standards	and Practices Commission (Commission)	
7	received a report from Jonathan Hill, Superintendent, Douglas County Educational Service			
8	District indicating that Michael Collins McGree (McGree) was then currently under investigation			
9	by the Department of Human Services.			
10	Mr. McGree fully cooperated with the Commission's investigation in this matter. After			
11	review of the matters alleged, Mr. McGree and the Commission agree that their respective			
12	interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts, the			
13	imposition of a public reprimand follo	owed by a tw	o (2) year probation.	
14	This document sets forth the	facts upon v	which the parties have agreed and the	
15	stipulated sanction to be imposed.	Mr. McGree	stipulates that there is sufficient evidence in the	
16	Commission's files and records to su	apport the fir	dings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set	
17	forth below.			
18	By signing below, Mr. McGre	e acknowled	lges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the	
19	following: (i) he has been fully advis	ed of his rig	nts to notice and a hearing to contest the	
20	findings of fact, conclusions of law, a	ind order se	forth below, and fully and finally waives all	
21	such rights and any rights to appeal	or otherwise	challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final	
22	Order of Reprimand and Probation (Stipulation a	nd Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final	
23	Order is a public document and disc	losed to the	public upon request by the Commission;

9	STIPULATION OF FACTS		
10	1. The Commission has licensed Michael Collins McGree since August 11, 1986. Mr.		
11	McGree currently holds a Standard Teaching License valid October 25, 2006, through October		
12	24, 2011, with a Standard Speech Impaired endorsement.		
13	2. Mr. McGree is currently employed by Douglas County Educational Service District as		
14	a full time teacher.		
15	3. On April 23, 2007, Mr. McGree plead no contest and was convicted of two (2) Counts		
16	of Harassment, a Class B Misdemeanor, arising out of a domestic dispute involving his wife and		
17	stepson.		
18	IT IS SO STIPULATED AND AGREED TO:

24	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW		
25	Michael Collins McGree plead no contest and was convicted of two (2) counts of		
26	Harassment arising out of a domestic dispute involving his wife and stepson. His conduct and		
27	conviction constitutes gross unfitness in violation of OAR 584-020-0040(5)(c). Conduct		

1	constituting gross unfitness may include conduct occurring outside of school hours and off of			
2	school premises when such conduct bears a demonstrable relationship to the educators' ability			
3	to fulfill professional responsibilities effectively. (c) Conviction of violating any federal, state, or			
4	local law. The Commission has the authority to impose discipline in this matter under ORS			
5	342.120 through 342.430 and OAR Chapter 584.			
6	FINAL ORDER			
7	The Commission hereby adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact,			
8	conclusions of law, and based thereon hereby imposes a Public Reprimand upon Mr. McGree.			
9	The Stipulation of Facts, Final Order and Probation constitutes the Reprimand.			
10	Furthermore, the Commission imposes a two (2) year probation upon Mr.			
11	McGree to commence the date of adoption of this order and subject to the following			
12	terms and conditions of probation:			
13	1. Mr. McGree shall report in writing within ten days to the Executive Director of the			
14	Commission any arrest or citation for any felony, misdemeanor, major traffic violation or			
15	violation of criminal probation; and			
16	2. Mr. McGree shall comply with the Standards for Competent and Ethical Performance			
17	of Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 584, Division 020.			
18	Violation of any term or condition of probation shall constitute an independent basis for			
19	the Commission to revoke Mr. McGree's teaching license or otherwise impose discipline, after			
20	first providing Mr. McGree with notice and opportunity for hearing.
